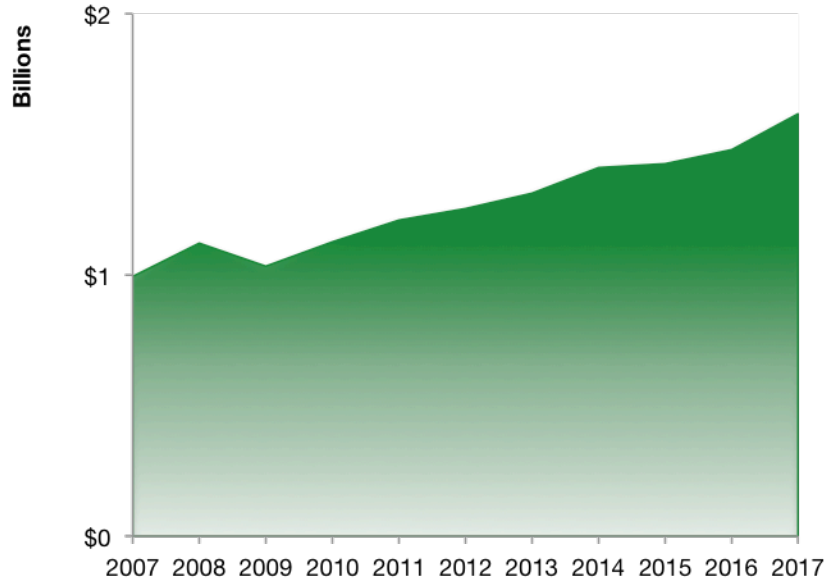
### Idaho Services Exports

#### U.S. Services Supply the World

Idaho has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2007, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$248 billion in 2017.

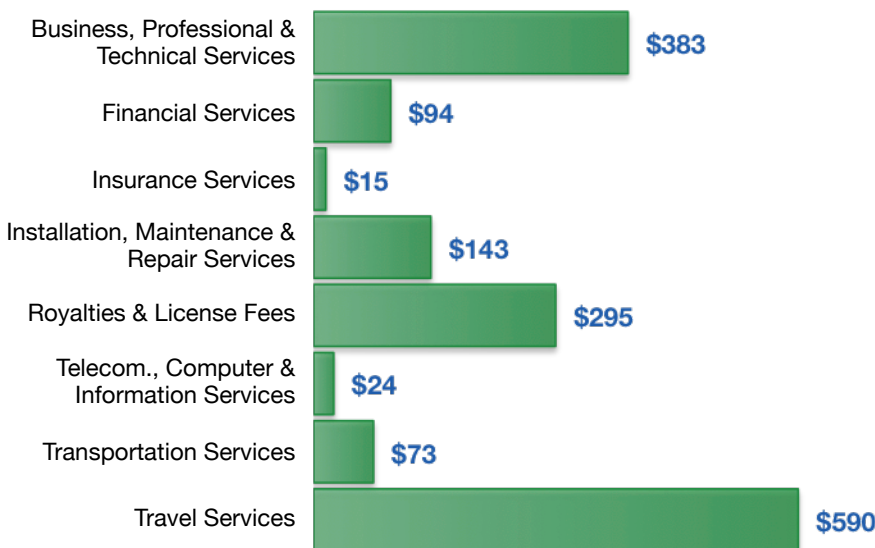

### Idaho Services Exports to Select Countries, 2017

- To China:** \$127 million in services exports supporting 1,020 jobs
- To Canada:** \$121 million in services exports supporting 910 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$81 million in services exports supporting 700 jobs
- To Korea:** \$56 million in services exports supporting 420 jobs
- To Japan:** \$90 million in services exports supporting 630 jobs
- To EU:** \$357 million in services exports supporting 2,270 jobs
- To UK:** \$115 million in services exports supporting 850 jobs

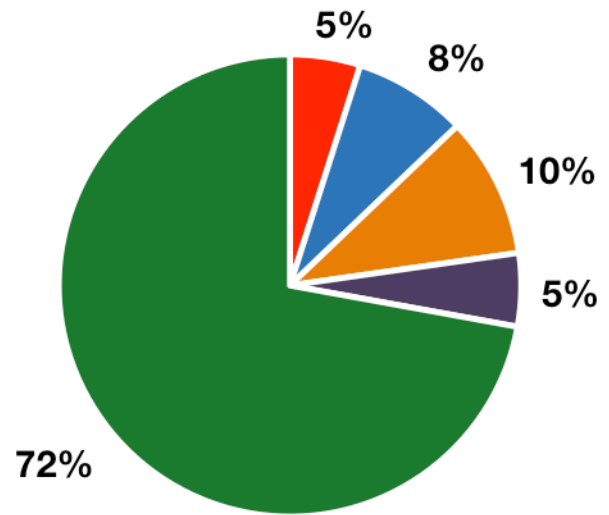

### Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 67 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

Services accounted for 72 percent of all jobs for Idaho workers in 2017. The top services sector for employment was Education, Health Care, & Social Assistance, which alone employed 174,340 Idaho workers.
