
U.S. Services Supply the World

ID-2 has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2009, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$260 billion in 2018.



ID-2 Services Exports to Select Countries, 2018

To China:	\$76 million in services exports supporting 600 jobs
To Canada:	\$67 million in services exports supporting 530 jobs
To Mexico:	\$45 million in services exports supporting 390 jobs
To Korea:	\$29 million in services exports supporting 220 jobs
To Japan:	\$50 million in services exports supporting 350 jobs
To EU:	\$222 million in services exports supporting 1,390 jobs
To UK:	\$66 million in services exports supporting 500 jobs



Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In ID-2, services accounted for 73 percent of all jobs in 2018. The top services sector for employment was educational services, and health care and social assistance, which alone employed 87,700 ID-2 workers.
