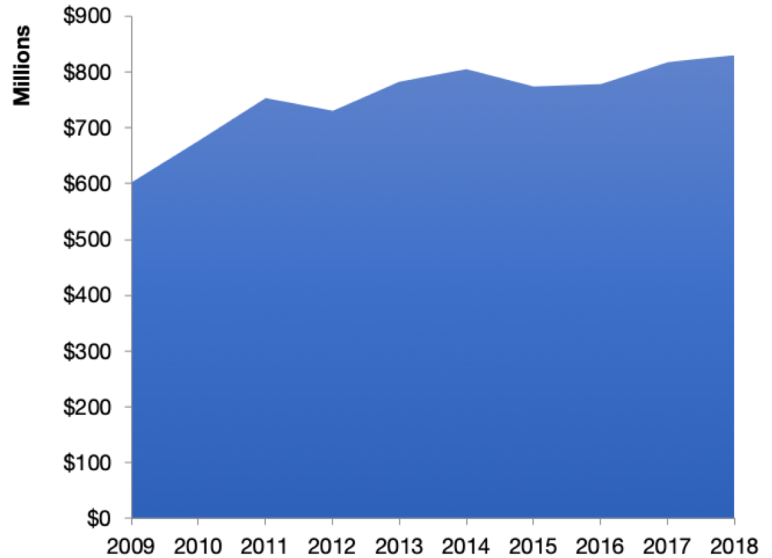
### U.S. Services Supply the World

WI-5 has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2009, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$260 billion in 2018.

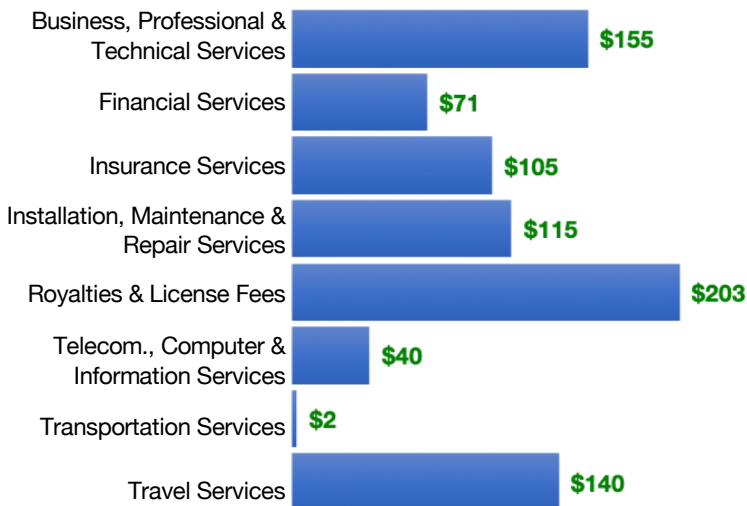

### WI-5 Services Exports to Select Countries, 2018

- To China:** \$49 million in services exports supporting 330 jobs
- To Canada:** \$66 million in services exports supporting 460 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$31 million in services exports supporting 230 jobs
- To Korea:** \$24 million in services exports supporting 150 jobs
- To Japan:** \$53 million in services exports supporting 340 jobs
- To EU:** \$179 million in services exports supporting 1,080 jobs
- To UK:** \$75 million in services exports supporting 500 jobs

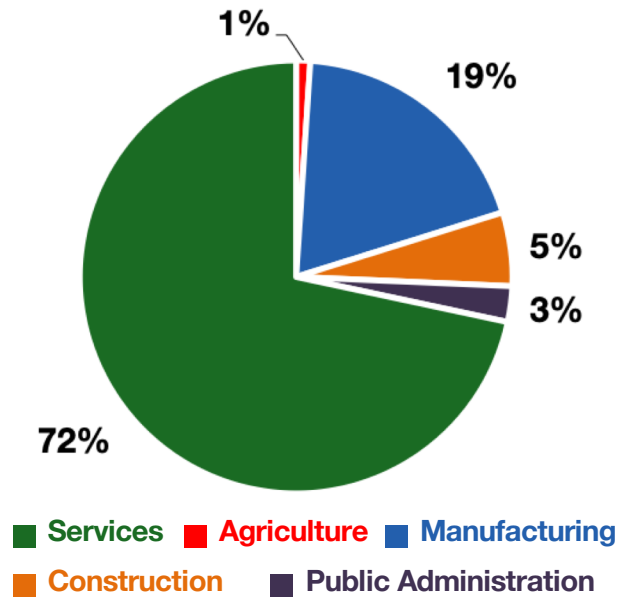

### Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In WI-5, services accounted for 72 percent of all jobs in 2018. The top services sector for employment was educational services, and health care and social assistance, which alone employed 91,000 WI-5 workers.
