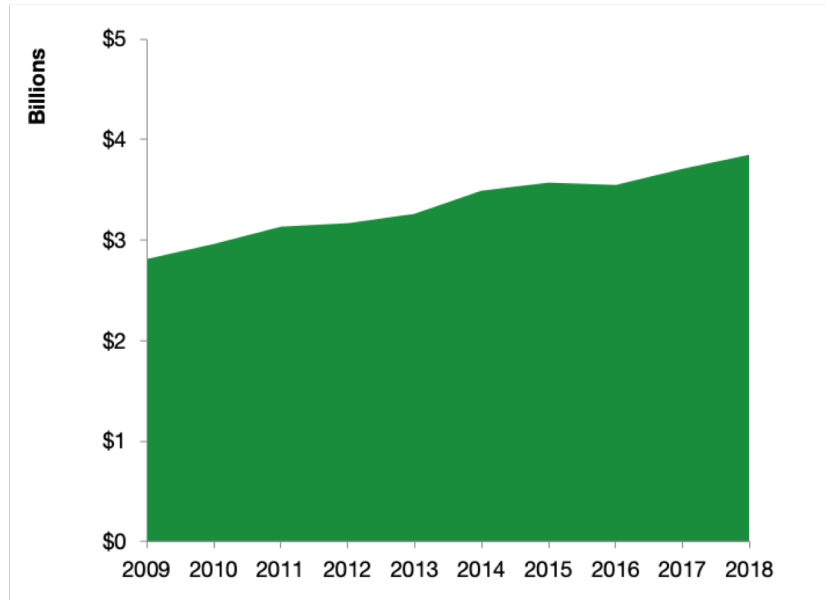
Kansas Services Exports

U.S. Services Supply the World

Kansas has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2009, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$260 billion in 2018.

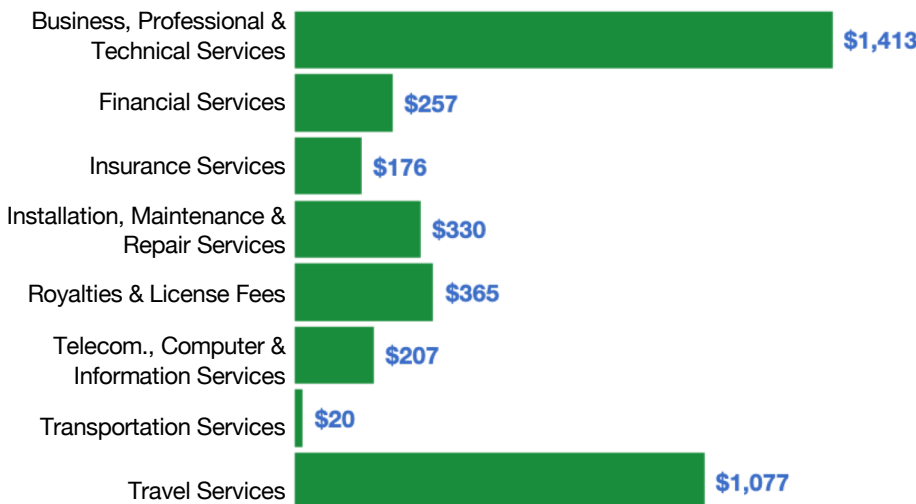

Kansas Services Exports to Select Countries, 2018

- To China:** \$278 million in services exports supporting 2,250 jobs
- To Canada:** \$279 million in services exports supporting 2,080 jobs

- To Korea:** \$96 million in services exports supporting 730 jobs
- To Japan:** \$198 million in services exports supporting 1,360 jobs
- To EU:** \$870 million in services exports supporting 5,800 jobs
- To UK:** \$322 million in services exports supporting 2,330 jobs

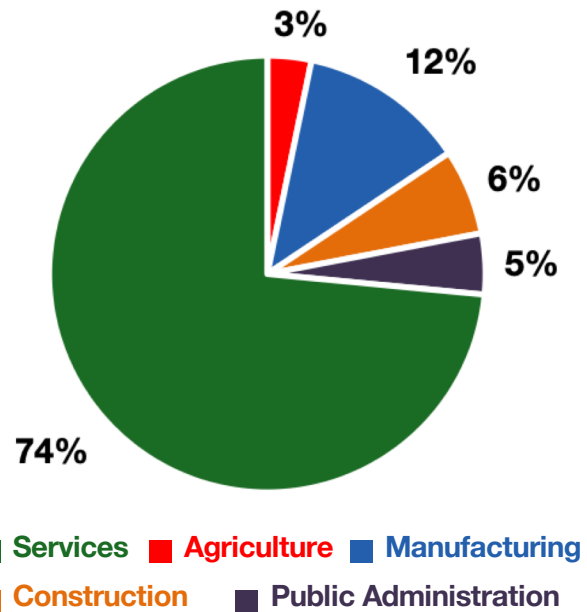

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Kansas, services accounted for 74 percent of all jobs in 2018. The top services sector for employment was educational services, and health care and social assistance, which alone employed 352,900 Kansas workers.
