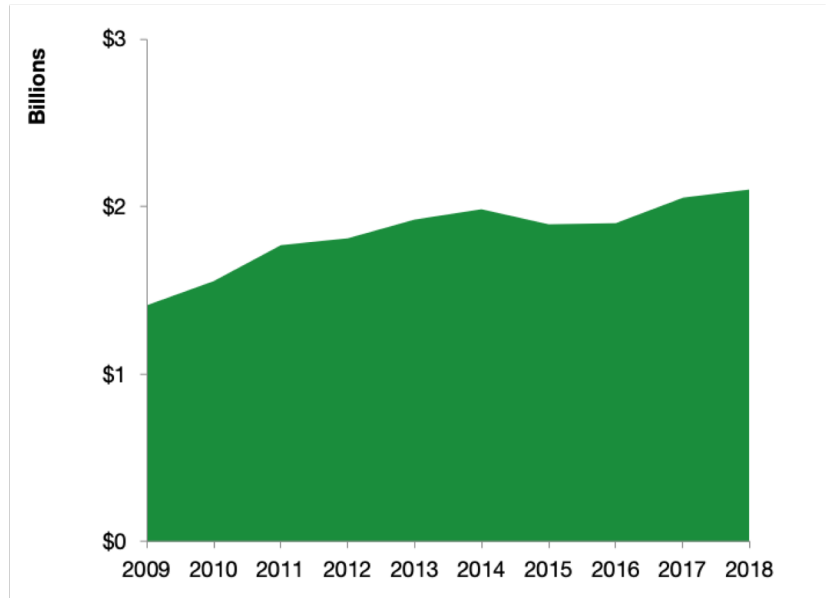
Rhode Island Services Exports

U.S. Services Supply the World

Rhode Island has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2009, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$260 billion in 2018.

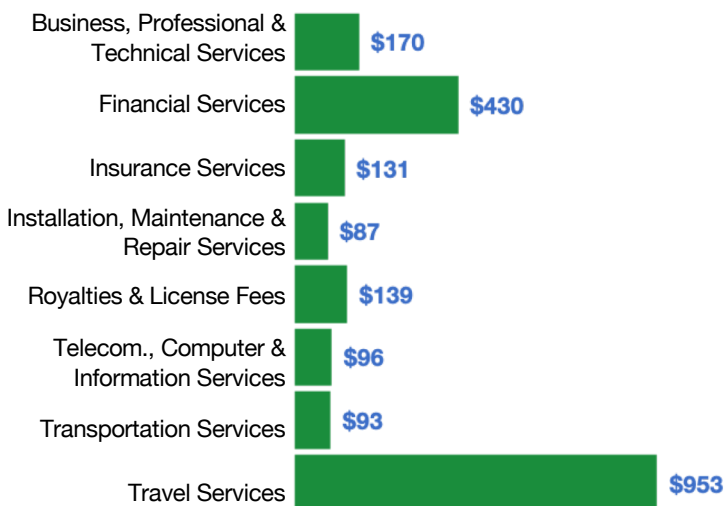

Rhode Island Services Exports to Select Countries, 2018

- To China:** \$201 million in services exports supporting 1,800 jobs
- To Canada:** \$166 million in services exports supporting 1,280 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$109 million in services exports supporting 920 jobs
- To Korea:** \$61 million in services exports supporting 520 jobs
- To Japan:** \$119 million in services exports supporting 850 jobs
- To EU:** \$372 million in services exports supporting 2,590 jobs
- To UK:** \$190 million in services exports supporting 1,320 jobs

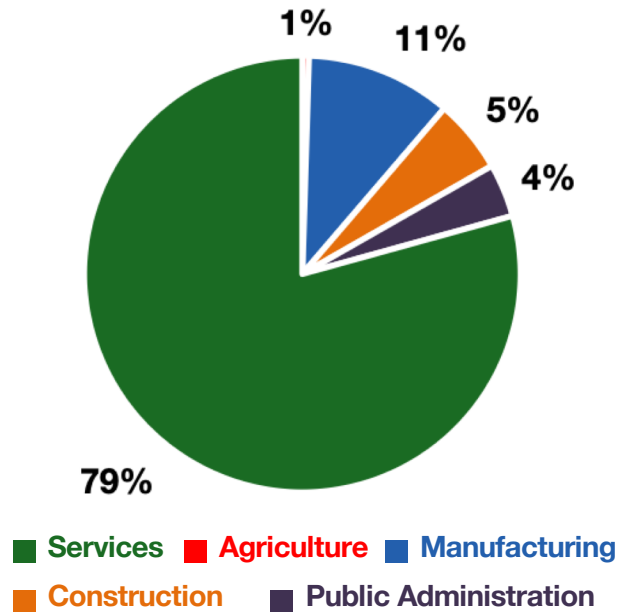

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Rhode Island, services accounted for 79 percent of all jobs in 2018. The top services sector for employment was educational services, and health care and social assistance, which alone employed 144,300 Rhode Island workers.
