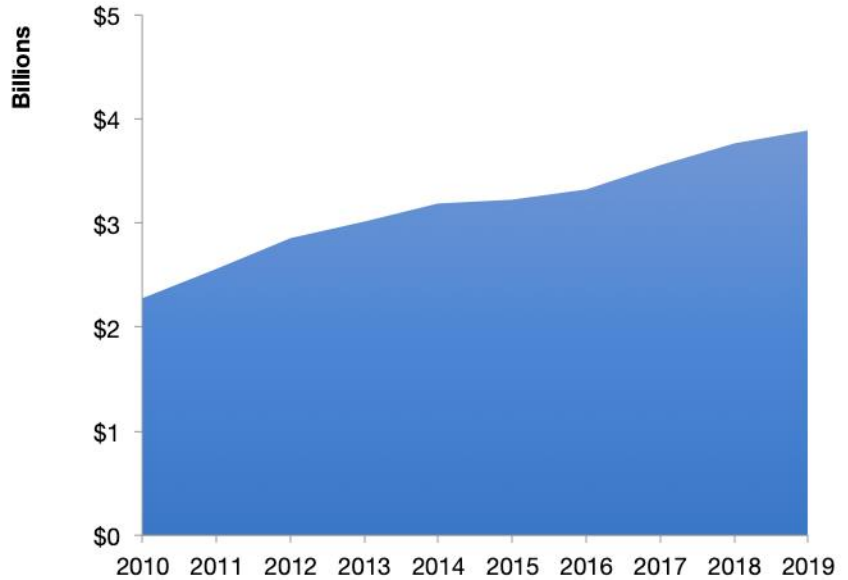
U.S. Services Supply the World

AZ-9 has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

The U.S. services industries are the most competitive and innovative in the world. They provide new economic opportunities and contribute to the successful production of manufacturing and agriculture in the United States and abroad.

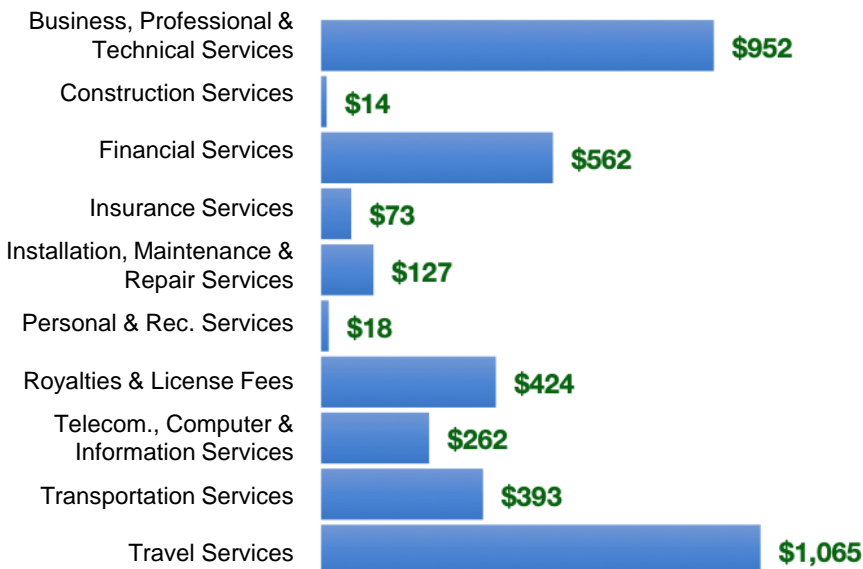

AZ-9 Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$314 million in services exports supporting 2,760 jobs
- To Canada:** \$305 million in services exports supporting 2,020 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$162 million in services exports supporting 1,210 jobs
- To Korea:** \$112 million in services exports supporting 830 jobs
- To Japan:** \$216 million in services exports supporting 1,310 jobs
- To EU:** \$872 million in services exports supporting 5,530 jobs
- To UK:** \$352 million in services exports supporting 2,250 jobs

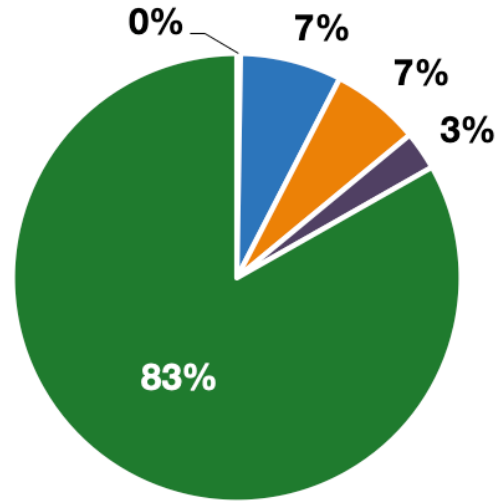

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In AZ-9, services accounted for 83 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 102,700 AZ-9 workers.
