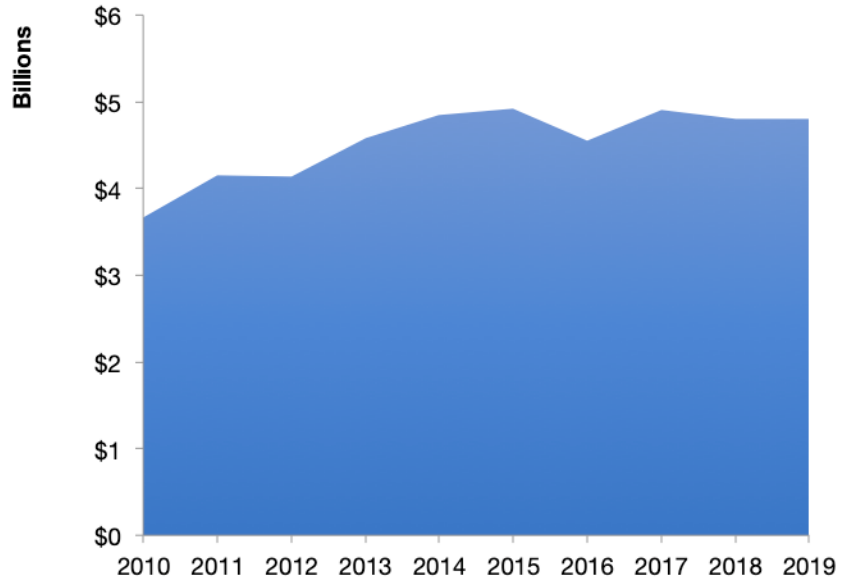
U.S. Services Supply the World

CT-4 has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

The U.S. services industries are the most competitive and innovative in the world. They provide new economic opportunities and contribute to the successful production of manufacturing and agriculture in the United States and abroad.

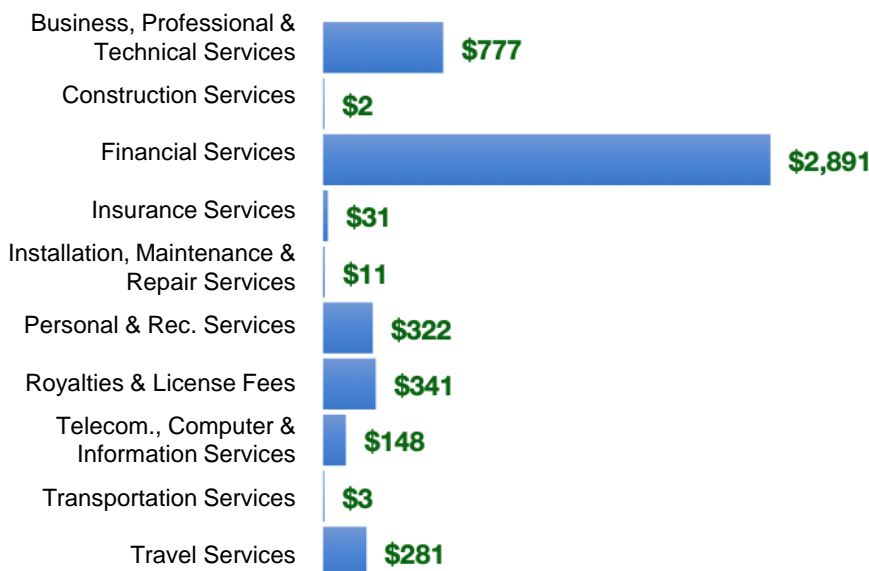

CT-4 Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$133 million in services exports supporting 890 jobs
- To Canada:** \$295 million in services exports supporting 1,560 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$83 million in services exports supporting 530 jobs
- To Korea:** \$67 million in services exports supporting 390 jobs
- To Japan:** \$205 million in services exports supporting 1,000 jobs
- To EU:** \$991 million in services exports supporting 4,930 jobs
- To UK:** \$517 million in services exports supporting 2,570 jobs

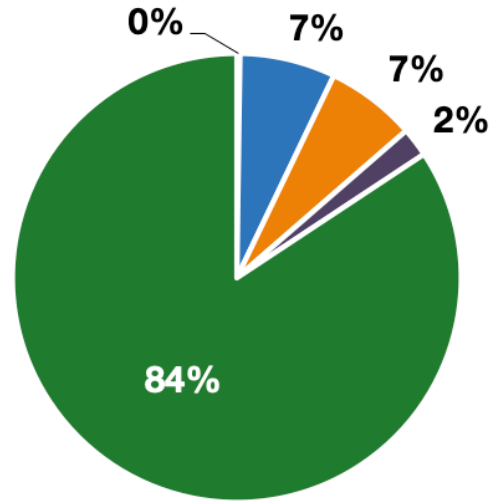

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In CT-4, services accounted for 84 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 80,600 CT-4 workers.
