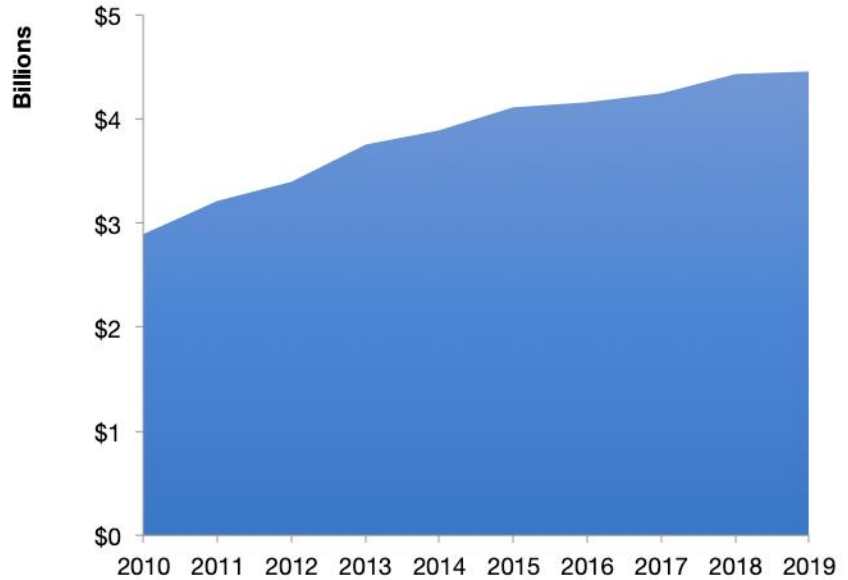
U.S. Services Supply the World

FL-10 has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

The U.S. services industries are the most competitive and innovative in the world. They provide new economic opportunities and contribute to the successful production of manufacturing and agriculture in the United States and abroad.

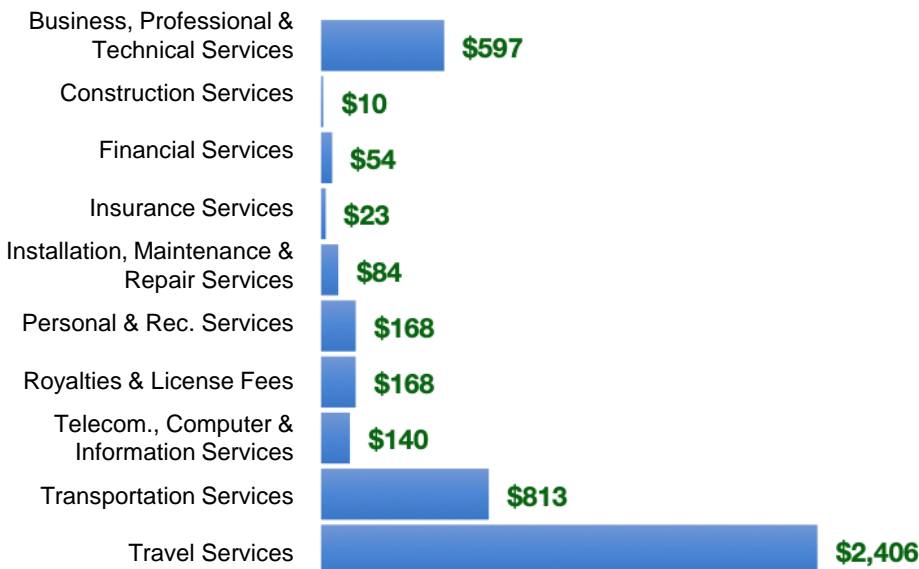

FL-10 Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$324 million in services exports supporting 2,740 jobs
- To Canada:** \$419 million in services exports supporting 3,400 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$285 million in services exports supporting 2,460 jobs
- To Korea:** \$143 million in services exports supporting 1,160 jobs
- To Japan:** \$253 million in services exports supporting 1,870 jobs
- To EU:** \$881 million in services exports supporting 6,800 jobs
- To UK:** \$401 million in services exports supporting 3,120 jobs

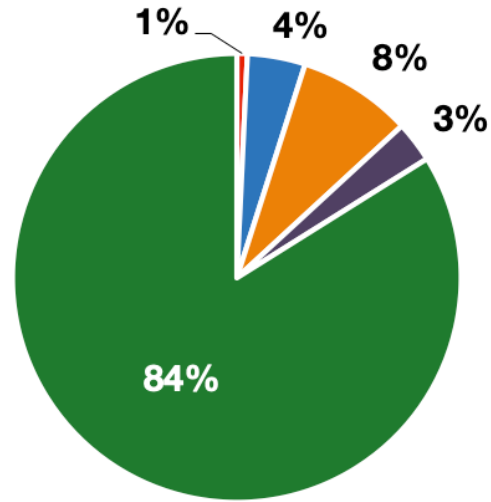

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In FL-10, services accounted for 84 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was arts, entertainment, accommodation, and food services, which alone employed 93,800 FL-10 workers.
