

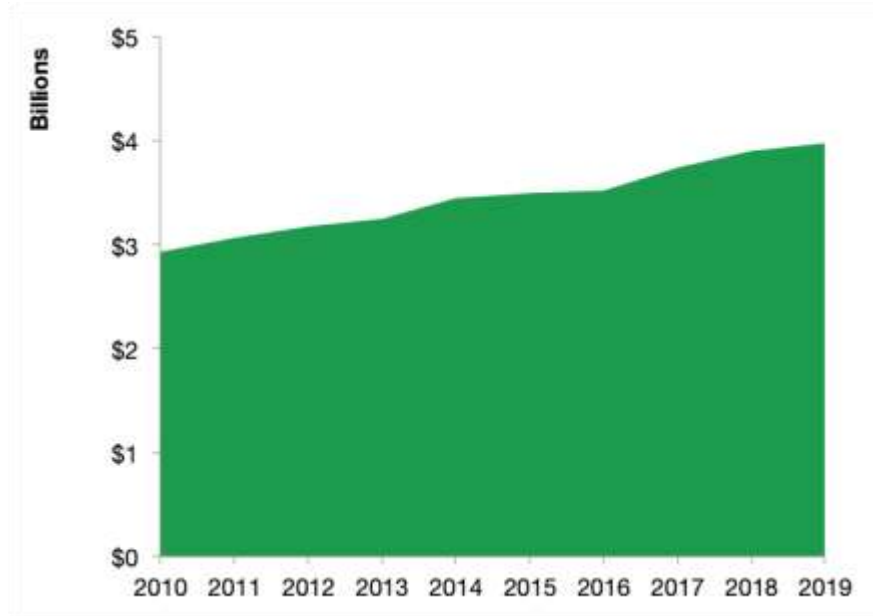

U.S. Services Supply the World

Kansas has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

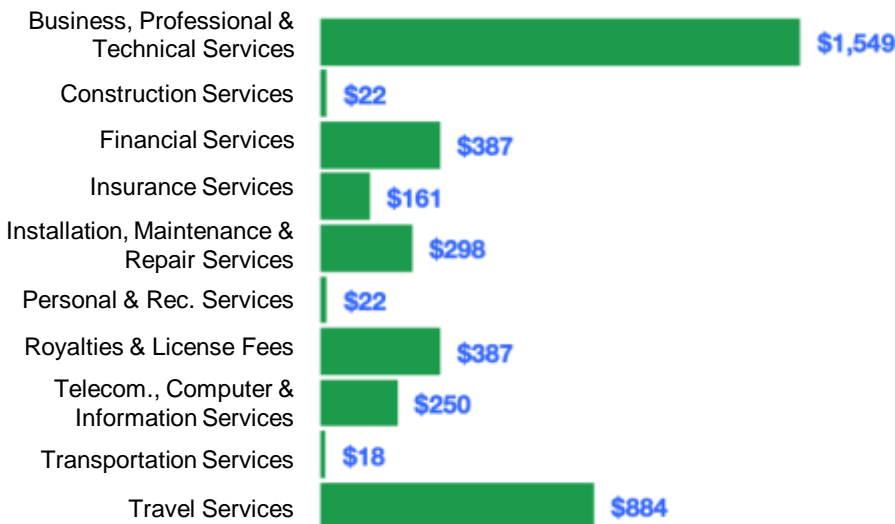

Kansas Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$261 million in services exports supporting 1,950 jobs
- To Canada:** \$283 million in services exports supporting 1,910 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$153 million in services exports supporting 1,120 jobs
- To Korea:** \$101 million in services exports supporting 710 jobs
- To Japan:** \$230 million in services exports supporting 1,370 jobs
- To EU:** \$980 million in services exports supporting 6,190 jobs
- To UK:** \$345 million in services exports supporting 2,300 jobs

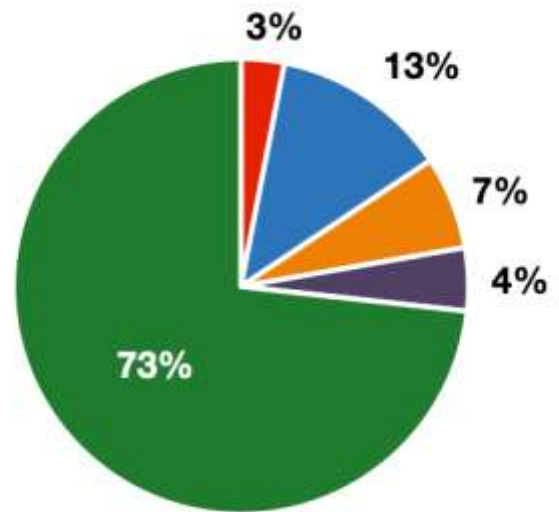

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Kansas, services accounted for 73 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 358,800 Kansas workers.
