

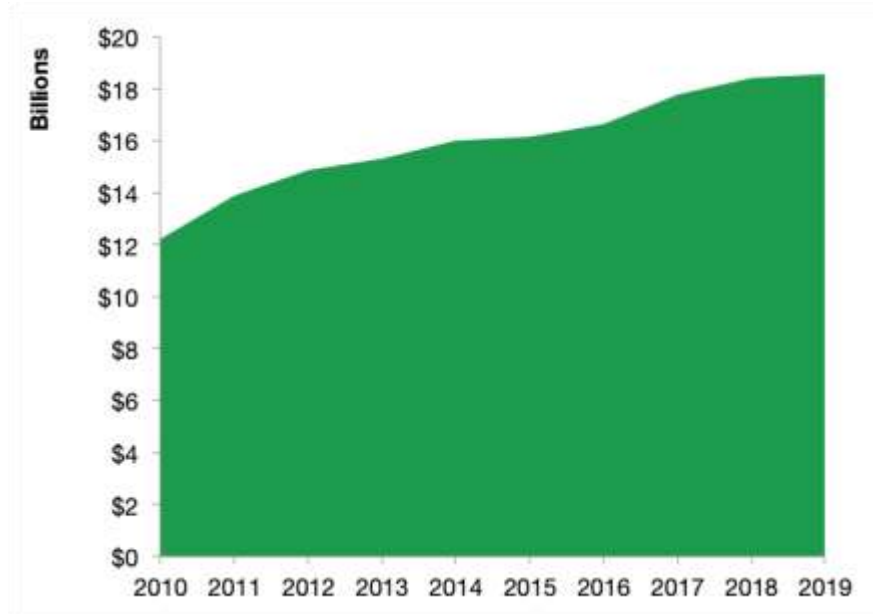

U.S. Services Supply the World

Ohio has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

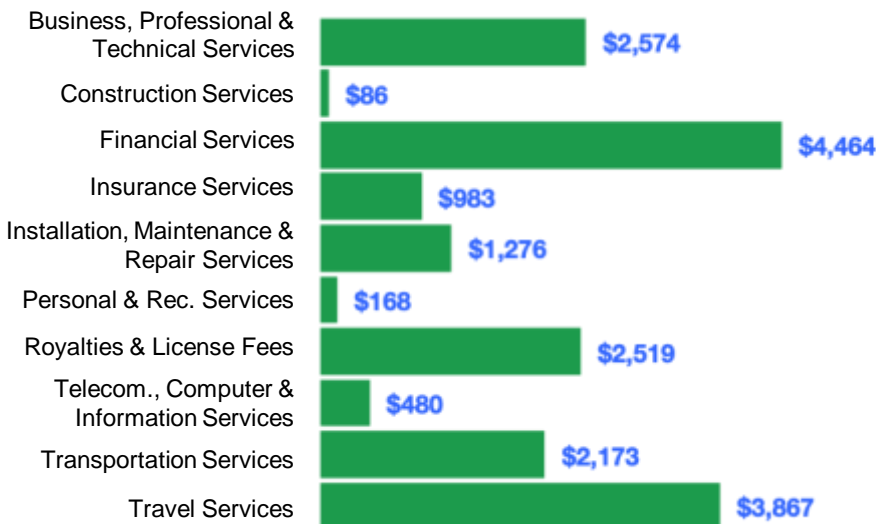

Ohio Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$1.4 billion in services exports supporting 10,400 jobs
- To Canada:** \$1.8 billion in services exports supporting 10,700 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$747 million in services exports supporting 5,130 jobs
- To Korea:** \$496 million in services exports supporting 3,340 jobs
- To Japan:** \$1.0 billion in services exports supporting 5,920 jobs
- To EU:** \$3.9 billion in services exports supporting 22,800 jobs
- To UK:** \$1.9 billion in services exports supporting 11,200 jobs

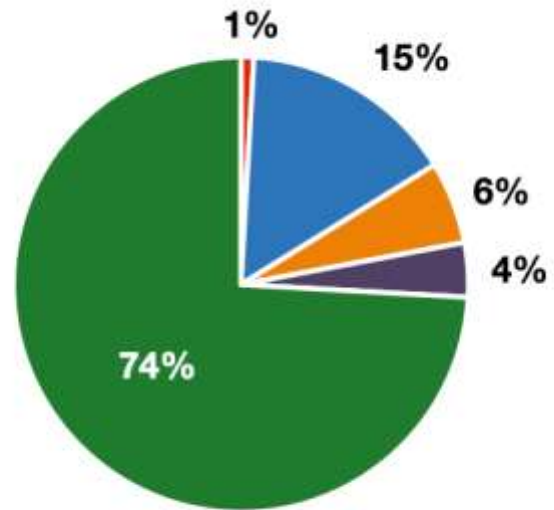

Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Ohio, services accounted for 74 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 1,370,300 Ohio workers.
