

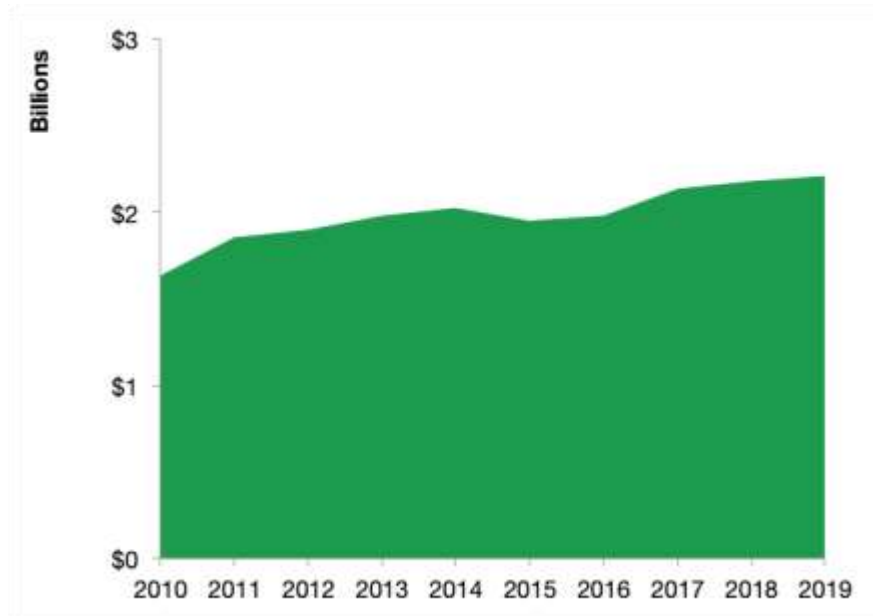

#### U.S. Services Supply the World

Rhode Island has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

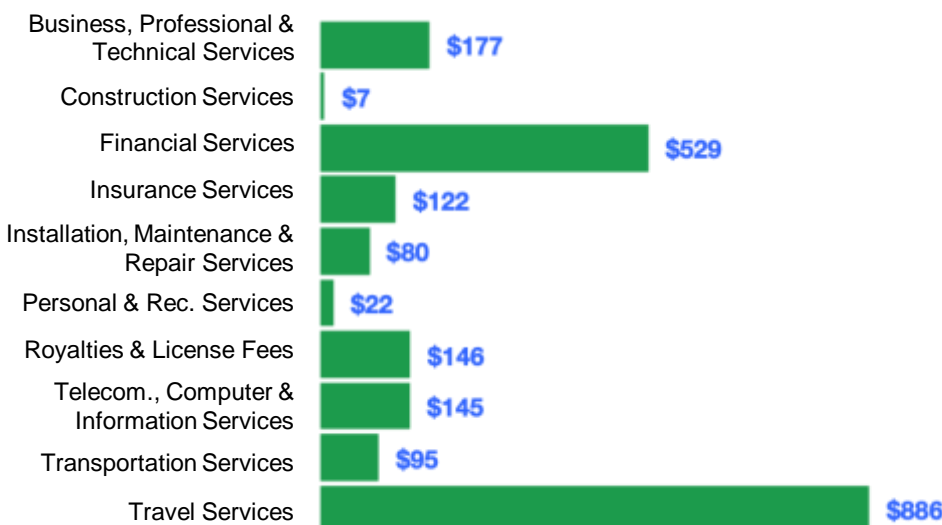

### Rhode Island Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$195 million in services exports supporting 1,690 jobs
- To Canada:** \$182 million in services exports supporting 1,280 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$108 million in services exports supporting 860 jobs
- To Korea:** \$58 million in services exports supporting 470 jobs
- To Japan:** \$130 million in services exports supporting 840 jobs
- To EU:** \$415 million in services exports supporting 2,720 jobs
- To UK:** \$215 million in services exports supporting 1,330 jobs

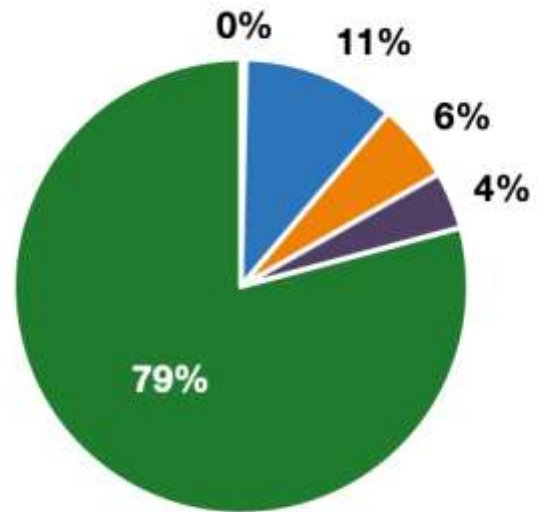

## Rhode Island

### Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Rhode Island, services accounted for 79 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 150,500 Rhode Island workers.
