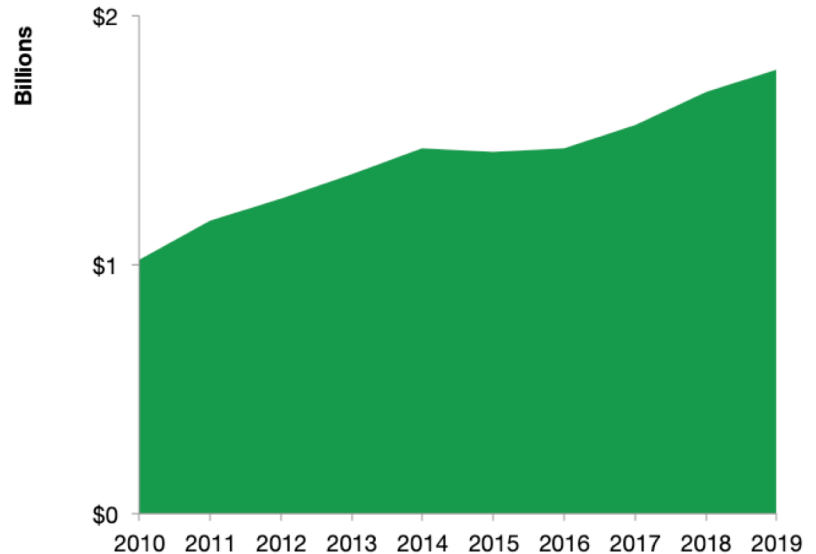
### South Dakota Services Exports

#### U.S. Services Supply the World

South Dakota has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

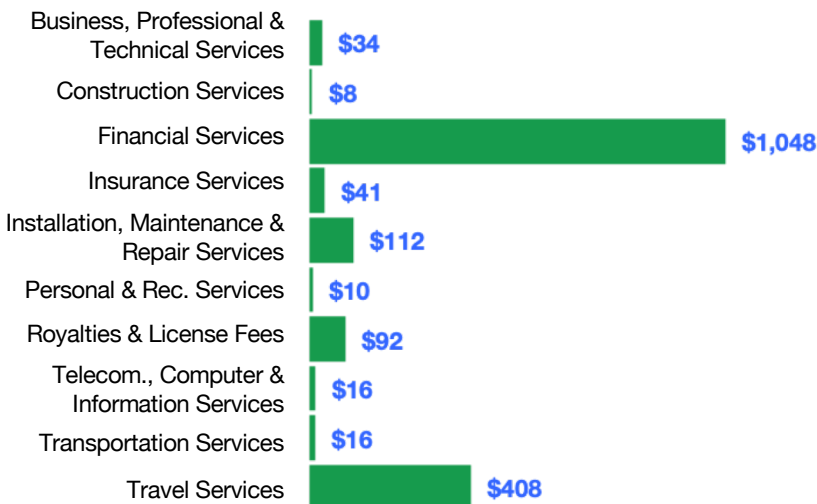

#### South Dakota Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$127 million in services exports supporting **810 jobs**

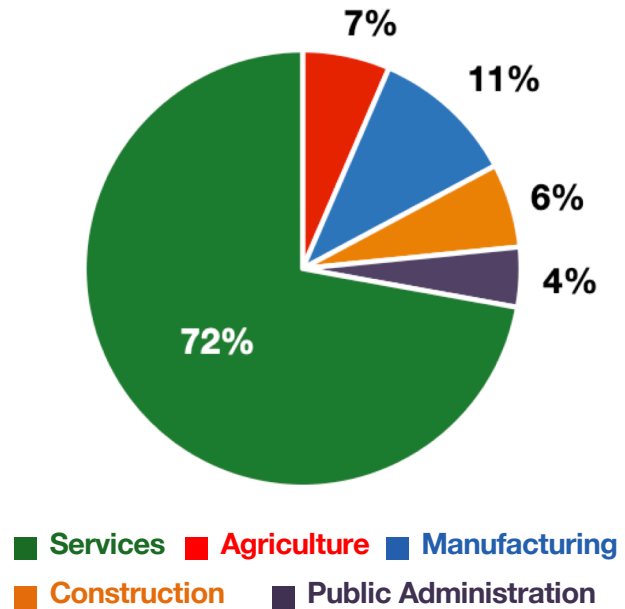

## South Dakota

### Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In South Dakota, services accounted for 72 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 110,600 South Dakota workers.
