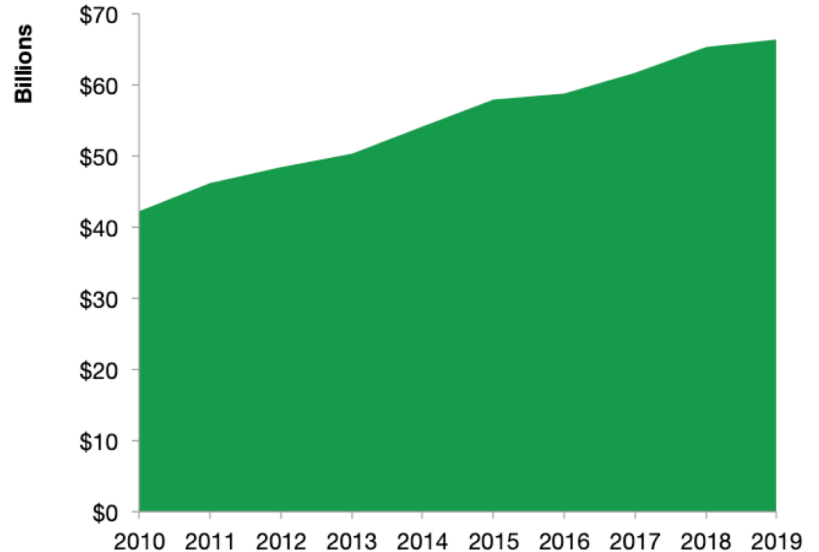
## Texas Services Exports

### U.S. Services Supply the World

Texas has seen a rise in overall services exports since 2010, boosting state economic growth and jobs, and contributing to the overall U.S. services trade surplus of \$289 billion in 2019.

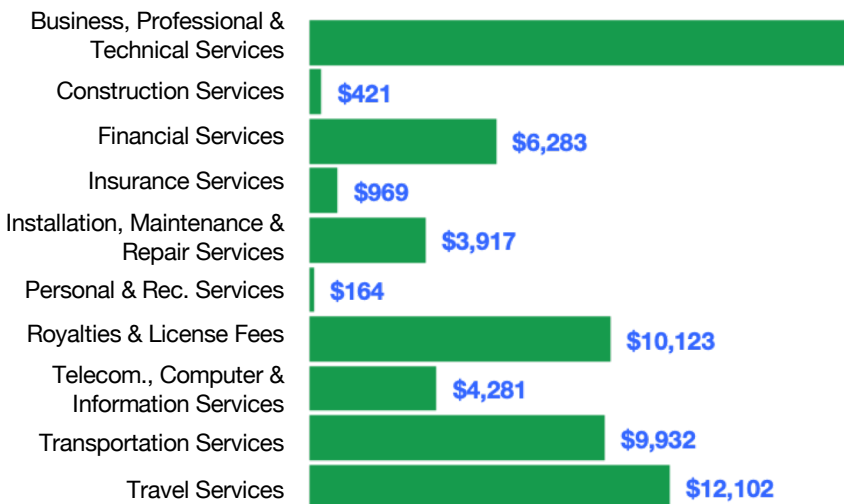

### Texas Services Exports to Select Countries, 2019

- To China:** \$4.0 billion in services exports supporting 28,500 jobs
- To Canada:** \$4.6 billion in services exports supporting 30,000 jobs
- To Mexico:** \$2.7 billion in services exports supporting 19,100 jobs
- To Korea:** \$2.2 billion in services exports supporting 13,500 jobs
- To Japan:** \$3.8 billion in services exports supporting 21,900 jobs
- To EU:** \$16 billion in services exports supporting 98,100 jobs
- To UK:** \$5.5 billion in services exports supporting 34,700 jobs

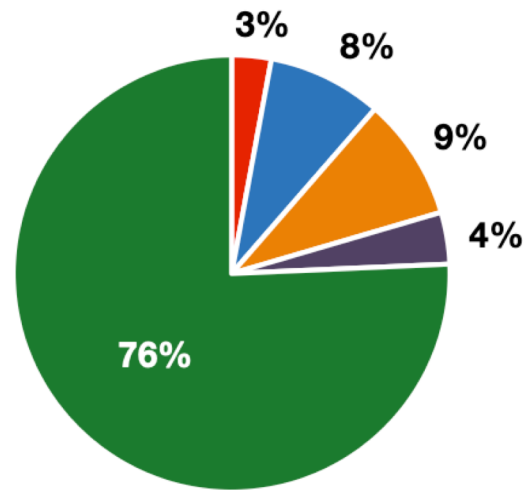

## Texas

### Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In Texas, services accounted for 76 percent of all jobs in 2019. The top services sector for employment was educational, health care, and social assistance services, which alone employed 2,960,900 Texas workers.
