
U.S. Services Supply the World

MS-2 has seen a rise in services exports, boosting state economic growth and jobs. In 2023, U.S. services exports topped \$1 trillion and the U.S. services trade surplus was \$278 billion.





Services Fuel U.S. Jobs and Growth

Services fuel America's economic growth and jobs, generating more than 77 percent of employment in the United States and 68 percent of GDP. Services are a major component of the manufacturing and agricultural sectors, and they boost the competitiveness of those sectors.

In MS-2, services accounted 73% percent of all jobs in 2023. The top services sector for employment was education services, health care and social assistance, which alone employed 70,490 MS-2 workers.
